Dear Braidwood Residents,

On March 16, 2020 leadership from the City of Braidwood, Braidwood Fire Protection District, Braidwood Police Department, Braidwood E.S.D.A. and Reed Township held a roundtable meeting to discuss the possibility of economic and social impacts to the residents and businesses of our community due to the current situation and orders from the state and federal governments surrounding the current COVID-19 virus crisis. While there have been no cases of COVID-19 within our community, our community leaders felt it best to try and get ahead of the game when it comes to ensuring that those faced with economic and financial challenges have access to food resources if needed.

## **Braidwood Community Care Center/Food Pantry**

If your gross household monthly income is less than the state guidelines for your family size shown in the chart below, and you are a resident of the communities the center serves, you are eligible for food assistance from COMMUNITY CARE CENTER

You simply need to visit the center during the hours of operation, show proof of residency within our service area, and certify the following with your signature: 1) that your monthly gross income does not exceed the DHS established limits, 2) that you will use the food received for household consumption only, and 3) that you release USDA, the State of Illinois, and any agency or person distributing food (including, but not limited to, Community Care Center) from all liabilities resulting from receipt of food.

**\*\*NOTE: During the current COVID-19 Crisis, maximum income affidavits do not need to be filled out by clients.**

Food assistance is available once every 30 days per household. Participation is free and does not affect eligibility for food stamps or any other assistance. Community Care Center is an entirely volunteer organization, staffed by people who simply care about others. No one receives any compensation for their time. The center is funded SOLELY through contributions & grants. Due to funding limitations, if you do not live within the center's service area, they may find it necessary to refer you to another food pantry. If you are unable to visit the food pantry on a day it is open, you may request a PROXY.

A PROXY is for the household who has handicapping conditions which make pick-up of pantry commodities by the recipient impossible. It may also be used to serve those whose work hours conflict with those of the scheduled distribution center. The PROXY must be signed by the eligible recipient and presented at the distribution center before any food may be received. A new PROXY is required for each visit. A PROXY form may be picked up at Community Care Center or Braidwood City Hall.
