

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-10**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 17-06 WHICH ESTABLISHED A TRANSFER AND CONVEYANCE OF REAL ESTATE PROPERTY TAX**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Braidwood, Will County, Illinois (City) is a municipality that operates as a commission form of government pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code 65 ILCS-1 et. seq. (City Council); and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that Ordinance 17-06 as adopted by the City Council on May 9, 2017 should be repealed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City council, the City of Braidwood, Will County, Illinois, as follows:


**SECTION 1:** Ordinance 17-06 which established a transfer and conveyance of real property tax is hereby repealed. Any tax paid or collected pursuant to Ordinance 17-06 shall be returned to the appropriate party within fourteen (14) days of the date of adoption of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, in conflict with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** Should any section, subsection or other provision in this Ordinance for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or a part thereof other than the portion declared invalid.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and filing as required by law.
