April 2, 2019

- Sep. 18 2018 First day to circulate petitions for new party, independent and nonpartisan candidates
Dec. 10-17 2018 Filing period
Dec. 24 2018 Last day to file objections to nominating petitions
Dec. 26 2018 Last day to conduct lottery for Dec. 10-17 filing period
Dec. 31 2018 Last day to file petition for public question
Dec. 31 2018 Last day to adopt a resolution or ordinance for binding/advisory public question
Jan. 24 2019 Certification of ballot by **Local Election Official**
Jan. 31 2019 Last day to file a Declaration of Intent to be a Write-In Candidate
Feb. 15 2019 First day any registered voter within the confines of the U.S. to make application by mail or in person to the E/A for an official ballot.
March 5 2019 Last day for registration
March 6 2019 First day for grace period registration and grace period voting
March 18 2019 First day for early voting
April 1 2019 Last day for early voting
April 2 2019 Last day for grace period registration and grace period voting

6. D-1 Statement of Organization
7. Fair Campaign Practices Form

Must be original signatures, no photo copies of signatures. Must all be bound together, numbered consecutively. Clerk must date and time stamp petitions.
